Recommendations of the State Advocacy workshop on Infant and young child feeding (IYCF) along with Dept. of Health, Jammu & Kashmir at GB Pant Children Hospital, Srinagar on 27th December 2013.

- 1. Appoint Infant and young child feeding (IYCF) specialist counselors with 7-day training. Begin with nurses and health counselors working in maternity area of government hospitals including those of medical colleges.
- 2. All private hospitals having maternity services, should be having IYCF counselors with specialized trainings as above in point 1.
- 3. Establish resource centers in medical colleges of Jammu and Srinagar to perform roles of research, training (including local translation of materials), ME, coordination, reporting to high-level committee.
- 4. Build state capacity /Prepare core pool of middle level trainers among district resource persons /health educators to enable them to train frontline workers in 4-days course.
- 5. Conduct gap analysis survey of policy and programme in 2014 and 2019 along with pre/post programme survey of practices at Distt. Level.
- 6. Impart skilled counselling as a servicer through ASHA and AWW and household level and through IYCF counselors at facility level.
- 7. Institutionalize pre-service training in medical and nursing colleges
- 8. Incorporate delivery of "Parent's Guide on Breastfeeding/IYCF" as education material along with MCP card during 3rd trimester of antenatal period.
- 9. Strengthen WBW activities every year.
- 10. Involve religious leaders during social mobilization.
- 11. High -level committee should review the IYCF activity every 3-6 months.
