Sub: Request to lead awareness in FOGSI Members about the IMS Act and stop violation of the IMS Act

Dear Dr. Gandhi,

This is further to the letter of Secretary, Health and Family Welfare, Government of India to you (D.O. No.2-28020/47 /2017 -CH Part (6) dated 18th August 2020) regarding the violation of the section 9.2 of the *Infant Milk Substitutes Feeding Bottles, and Infant Foods* (*Regulation of Production, Supply and Distribution*) *Act* 1992, and Amendment Act 2003.

I would like to draw your attention to the continued activities of the FOGSI units, which have come to our attention. I am attaching information about two such activities going to happen on15th and 16th September 2020. (Please see attached posters of these events)

May I request you to kindly communicate to all your federation member societies about such sponsorship being in violation of the law IMS Act. It seems they are not aware of the provisions of the law. Allow me to share additional information (Annex-1) with you that clearly show that Abbott is one and same company manufacturing and marketing a number of products. The arguments usually given that it is another division of Abbott that sponsors do not stand the test of truth.

We therefore request you to use your good offices to share with your sub national members of FOGSI; the Letter of Secretary Health, information on IMS Act provisions, and information about Abbott being one company responsible for all its products. As FOGSI you can also request them to desist from getting sponsored by the companies that are manufacturers of baby foods for children under 2 years.
